TIME COMMITMENT

Even though the Articles show a minimum number of meetings we meet as a council 4 times a year and members would also be expected to be involved in at least one sub-group, and/or other committees in which Surrey Chambers is a key partner. Council members are expected to attend at least 3 of the 4 meetings plus at least 2 major events, which will be identified at the beginning of the year. Missing more than 2 meetings consecutively effectively results in resignation from the Council except in special circumstances. (At the discretion of the President)

Finally, as an organisation, we are committed to helping businesses in Surrey to match best practice standards in their business operations and in the training and development of their employees. We run and promote a variety of programs to help businesses achieve these standards.
